



Noah Brown Jr. Scholarship Fund for Detroit Public High School Graduates

Deadline: April 3, 2019

Award Amount Varies: \$900 - \$1,300

Number of Recipients: 2-3

This scholarship is provided to graduates of Detroit Public High Schools who are full-time students and have completed a Wayne State University ACCESS program. This scholarship is limited to students completing their junior year who demonstrate commitment to academic excellence and community service. Recipients are selected based upon academic excellence, community service and financial need.

Eligibility

- Attended a Detroit Public High School
- Junior (rising senior)
- Full-time student
- A minimum 2.5 GPA
- Previous winners cannot apply

Requirements

- Complete the Noah Brown Jr. Scholarship Fund Application and Essay
- Must have the FAFSA completed before April 3, 2019
 Attach a copy of your Student Aid Report (SAR) with the application
- Must attach a copy of your official transcript (proof of high school)
- Resume
- Nomination Form completed by a TRIO program employee

The applicant and nominator should download the form and electronically fill-in the application, essay and e-signature. No late or incomplete submissions will be accepted. No extensions will be granted.
